When do lessons take place?

Lessons currently run Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons.

Swim School term dates

Our swim school terms range from 10-14 weeks and follow the academic calendar. We always have a break from lessons for half term. If bank holidays fall during the term, lessons continue to go ahead. However we try to avoid this.

How to join

2. You will then be contacted to arrange a pupil assessment (assessments are necessary to make sure your child is allocated the correct group for their ability).
3. Assessments take approximately 15 to 20 minutes and are free of charge. The teacher will inform you after the assessment which class your child would be suitable for.
4. Please take your assessment form to reception, where they will look up the availability of the required class.
5. Fill out a booking form and pay for the remainder of the term to secure your place.
6. Payment is made termly not per lesson. You can pay by cash, cheque (made payable to Sherborne Sports and Leisure Limited) or card, either at reception or over the phone.

Crash Courses

An opportunity to top up technique or learn a new skill.

Aims: Water confidence, songs and activities.
Group Size: Maximum 10 children per group.

Fundamentals

Class Names: Three ability levels **Chick-F1**, **Cygnets-F2** and **Gosling-F3**.
Age: 4 years +
Group Size: Maximum 6 children per group.
Ability: Non-swimmers to becoming self-sufficient on front and back.

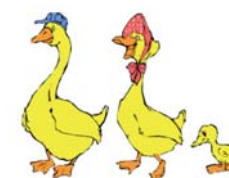
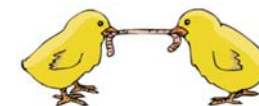

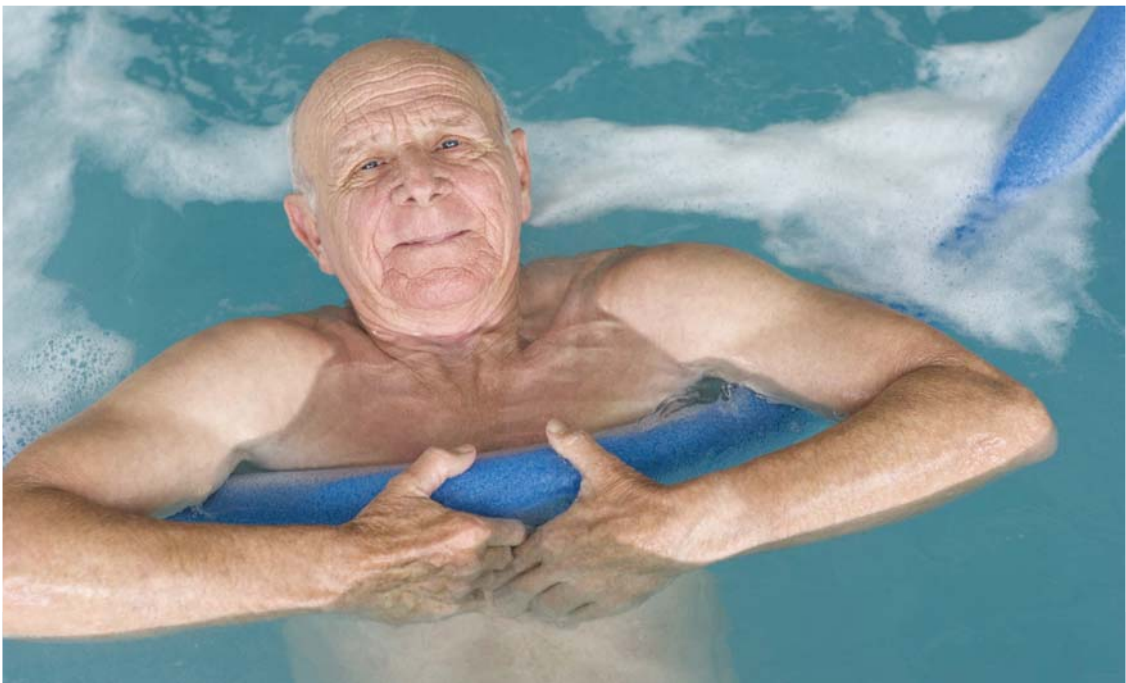
Class Names: Six ability levels: **Puffin-P1**, **Pelican-P2**, **Stork-P3**, **Heron-P4**, **Flamingo-P5** and **Eagle-P6/7**.
Age: Four and a half years and above, allocated on ability.
Group Size: Maximum of 8 children in a group.
(12 in Flamingo/Eagle)
Ability: Improving technique and increasing distance.

Gulls Swim Club

Class Name: **Gulls-G1**
Age: Allocated on ability.
Group Size: Maximum 14 children per group.
Ability: Advanced swimmers 50m or 100m swims for each activity. Includes water polo, lifesaving, and competitive starts and turns.

Hats and certificates are provided free of charge for all children in progression and club level classes.





Adult Lessons

Currently we have two options, they are as follows:

Monday evenings 9.00pm to 10.00pm

- Beginners / Improvers
- Advanced Swimmers. The advanced lesson is called Swim Fit and includes technique correction and fitness training for Masters Swimmers and Triathletes.

Terms and Conditions of Oxley Swim School

The centre reserves the right to change or cancel lessons if there are insufficient applicants to make it viable.

The Centre reserve the right to alter the times and dates of the courses if deemed necessary.

Priority booking is given to those swimmers already on the scheme.

It is possible to enrol after the course has started where places are available, payment is pro-rata.

Places will only be guaranteed when full payment has been received.

Payment can be made either by cash, cheque (made payable to Sherborne Sports and Leisure Limited) or by card either over the phone or in person.

Refunds are only given in extenuating circumstances. All applications for refunds should be submitted to the Swim School Manager and their decision will be final.
